Guy was accompanied by Sidon MP Bahia Hariri's representative, Ali al-Sharif, Sidon Mayor Mohammad Saudi's representative, Ibrahim Bsar, and members of the municipal council.

Following an explanation by the head of the British Museum delega-

tion, Claude Doumit Serhal, on the excavation's recent archaeological discoveries, Guy said: "I came here for the first time around four years ago, and each year I see the efforts of those engaged in excavation works reveal something new dating back to a very old time."
