

Phoenician priest Rare find unearthed in Sidon

A statue of a Phoenician priest has been uncovered at the Freres College excavation site in the southern city of Sidon, along with other antiquities, the British Museum excavation in the city announced Monday. The statue, which dates to the sixth century B.C., is the most unique find for Lebanon over the last few decades.
